

Proactive safety for the National Rally, Covid-19 concerns/guidelines.

The State of Louisiana is rapidly moving toward fully reopening. As we mentioned before, they have moved to their phase three, allowing for larger gatherings and lifting most restrictions.

Out of abundance of caution, and to respect those members who have any concern, we are committed to following any mitigation at our event that may remain.

We will be providing masks and small personal bottles of hand sanitizer in each welcome bag. Members will be encouraged to use them and right now Louisiana wants folks to.

Each chapter will be provided with one or more “free spaces”, (empty RV sites) in their area to allow for chapter socials and any social distancing needs that may be present, at no cost to the chapters.

For questions about the indoor rally space, think of the room being the size of the Staple Center in L.A. they hold their large concerts in there with hundreds if not thousands of people. The Convention center main room, by far is really too big for our typical needs, however it allows for exaggerated spacing as needed.

The meeting rooms and rooms for things like the ladies luncheon are big as well and can be expanded to our needs and their requirements.

Table seating for our evening and morning events, will be limited to 6 folks max in order to allow for distancing. Moving tables together is not allowed. The dance floor will be huge as well and distancing encouraged.

Food service is either table service or modified buffet where you point and staff places the item(s) on your plate, this to reduce any chances of infection. Any buffet lines or cash bar lines will be managed for distancing as well.

Additionally each entrance will have sanitizer stations, and passive temperature checks will occur as you enter the facility.
